4-H Camp Kidwell's counselor in training program is designed to introduce young people to the responsibilities and skills that are needed to be a quality counselor. C.I.T.'s have a specific set of responsibilities they must perform everyday as well as a variety of opportunities to experience what goes into being a great staff member.

Salary: Volunteer

General Requirements:

- Must help set up for, prepare, and serve meals and do dishes for all meals
- Must attend and participate in C.I.T. orientation week
- Must have desire to work with children
- Must work well with others
- Must be able to follow directions
- Must be able to maintain a positive attitude
- Must be a team player
- Must be willing to participate in all camp activities
- Must stay at camp and live in cabin with campers
- Must have all health forms, tests and any related info up to date. I.E.-T.B. test, tetanus shot, etc.
- Must be willing to volunteer at least two weeks through the summer.

Specific Requirements:

- Must be at least 14 years old
- Have current certification in CPR and first aid

Job Description:

- Work in Kitchen for a minimum two meals each day. I.E. set tables, assist camp cook in preparing and serving meals, washing dishes, sweeping and mopping floors, taking out garbage, etc.
- Job shadow counselors and program staff members to gain experience
- Assist in running programs and activities
- Assist in maintaining an orderly and productive cabin atmosphere.
- Report any incidents and concerns to the camp director
- These are not the only duties to be performed. Duties may be added or reassigned as required.
