How to register

#1 We encourage you to register online. Through our safe and secure site you provide all necessary information. We hope you find this service convenient and easy to use. Visit our website, www.campkidwell.org to get started. After you have created your online account you can visit any time to make changes, add payments or additional information. If you registered with us online last year, all you will need is your email address and password. This option is provided through Camp register, one of the best online registration programs in the world. Visit www.campregister.com for more details about the program.

#2 Fill out the camper registration form on the back of this form and return it to the MSU Extension office at **MSUE, camper registration, Human Services Building, 3255 122nd Ave, Suite 101 Allegan, MI 49010**. Checks should be made payable to 4-H Camp Kidwell. A receipt of registration will be sent to you immediately to confirm that we received your registration. Then, in the late spring, you will receive a packet of information with details about the upcoming summer as well as paper work that will need to be filled out.

Programs offered

We offer Day and Resident camp programs for children ages 5 to 16!

Resident Camp – Children 8 to 16 are eligible for resident camp. The children arrive on Sunday evening and stay until Friday afternoon! A variety of activities are offered ranging from horseback riding to swimming and rock climbing!

Day Camp – Children 5 to 14 are eligible. Children arrive each morning around 8 am and go home each evening around 5:30, Monday thru Friday. Day campers participate in the same activities resident campers do, but their schedule is shaped with their development levels in mind.

Scholarship Assistance

4-H Camp Kidwell works very hard to offer scholarship assistance to those in need. If you are in need of assistance, please check the box on the bottom left of the registration form. Scholarship funds vary from year to year, and are available on a first come, first serve basis. Announcements regarding scholarship availability will not be made until the spring of 2008. If paid after this date, the total fee is due with the completed registration form. The obligation of the Camp for its counselors, employees and general expenses are fixed for the summer and the absence of a camper does not lessen the operation expenses. Therefore, no refund or deductions will be made for campers who arrive late or leave early. When a camper must leave Camp upon the direction of 4-H Camp Kidwell's physician or the family physician, the parent and the Camp will share the loss of tuition equally. Camp Kidwell reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper whose behavior is disruptive to the operation of Camp. Campers who receive any type of scholarship are not eligible for discounts.
