How to register

#1 Online Registration - This safe, secure, convenient and easy to use service makes registering very simple. With a few clicks of the mouse and taps of the keyboard you can have your children registered and ready to attend an exciting week of camp. Visit our website, www.campkidwell.org to get started. After you have created your online account you can visit any time to make changes, add payments or additional information. If you registered with us online last year, all you will need is your email address and password. #2 Mail-in Registration - Fill out the camper registration form on the back of this form and return it to the MSU Extension office at **MSUE, camper registration, Human Services Building, 3255 122nd Ave, Suite 101 Allegan, MI 49010**. Checks should be made payable to 4-H Camp Kidwell. A receipt of registration will be sent to you immediately to confirm that we received your registration. More details about your time with us will follow!

Programs offered

We offer Day and Resident camp programs for children ages 4 to 16! All programs are designed with the camper's developmental levels in mind and maintain a minimum 1 to 8 staff/camper supervision ratio.

Resident Camp – Children 7 to 16 are eligible to attend resident camp. Children stay in cabins on site for 5 nights and 6 days and participate in a wide variety of activities such as swimming, horseback riding, arts and crafts and much more. Each session/week starts when campers arrive on Sunday evening at 6 pm and ends when they leave Friday afternoon at 2 pm!

Day Camp – Children 4 to 14 are eligible to attend day camp. Our day camp program allows children to enjoy all the wonders of camp while helping younger children feel comfortable away from home and letting the very busy child attend camp but keep prior commitments. Children arrive each morning around 8 am and go home each evening around 5:30, Monday thru Friday, except on Friday when pick is at 2 pm. Day campers participate in many of the same activities resident campers do, while enjoying a schedule designed to fit their developmental needs.

Scholarship Assistance

We work very hard to offer scholarship assistance to those in need. Our scholarship program is based on financial need and uses the same guidelines as the schools use for free and reduced lunch. If you're eligible for free lunch you are eligible for a full scholarship and if you are eligible for reduced lunch you are eligible for a half scholarship. Scholarship funds vary from year to year, and are available on a first come, first serve basis. If you fall into the criteria above and would like to apply for assistance, please check the box in the bottom left of the registration on the reverse side. You will be contacted in late spring/early summer to let you know if you qualify and if funding is available.

Therefore, no refund or deductions will be made for campers who arrive late or leave early. When a camper must leave Camp upon the direction of 4-H Camp Kidwell's physician or the family physician, the parent and the Camp will share the loss of tuition equally. Camp Kidwell reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper whose behavior is disruptive to the operation of Camp. Campers who receive any type of scholarship are not eligible for discounts.
