ARRIVAL AND PICK UP DETAILS

ARRIVAL: Monday-Friday @ 9am

- Campers eat lunch with us each day. Please be sure they have breakfast before arriving.
- Monday arrival will start at 8:30am to accommodate the 1st day check in process.
 - During check-in on Monday, we will need to review all registration information, visit the health officer(if necessary), and set-up a camp store account for your camper. Please be prepared for this process to take 30-45 minutes as we will be checking in several campers at the same time.
- Tuesday-Friday, you will be greeted at your car by a staff member who will sign-in and gather your camper
- Please do not hesitate to ask questions...our first priority is the safety of our campers and making sure parents have all the information they need is part of that process. All staff members are happy to help, please ask!

PICKUP: Monday-Thursday @ 5pm, Friday @ 2pm

- Campers will be engaged in activities until you arrive but will be packed and ready for you when you arrive.
- All campers MUST BE SIGNED OUT each day
 - A staff member will greet you in the parking lot to sign your camper out..
 - Only individuals listed as authorized pick-ups on your online account will be allowed to pick up campers.
 - Photo ID is required for us to release a camper.
 - If you would like to add or remove someone from your authorized pick up list, please do so online and contact our office.
 - For the safety of our campers, if an individual arrives to pick up a camper that is not listed on the authorized person list(this includes parents who have not been added) the camper WILL NOT be released.
 - We will share successes and any areas of concern at pickup.
 - Please let staff members know if you have questions or need to make any arrangements. We are all happy to help.
 - Picking up campers at different times is completely "OK."
 - We just ask that you consider that missing a lot of time with their group may affect their experience.
 - We also need you to let us know ahead of time if you do need to pick your campers up early, so we can do our best to have them ready for you.

PACKING DETAILS

- Campers should have a duffel bag or backpack for their items.
- Send an extra set of clothes each day...Fun at camp occasionally gets messy.
- Be sure to check their bag each morning before camp to make sure everything is clean and fresh for the day.
- **THIS CAN'T BE EMPHASIZED ENOUGH!!!! PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO PUT INITIALS ON ALL OF YOUR CAMPERS BELONGINGS!!!**
 - We want all campers to go home with their belongings!
 - Believe it or not, campers are messy when they are having fun and learning to be independent!!!! There is a 100% chance belongings **WILL** get mixed up or misplaced. Let me repeat...there is 100% chance belongings will get mixed up or misplaced! *By all means though, if you have a way to stop this, please contact us! We are all ears!!!!*
 - It isn't 100% that things will get back to you, even with initials!!! However, there is a significantly higher chance if there are initials on them.
 - After each session(even after staff members holding items up and asking who things belong to as well as having a lost and found table for campers to look through) we have **MULTIPLE** articles of clothing, water bottles, and other personal belongings that never find a home. Please help us be sure your camper takes their belongings home!
- ***SPECIAL NOTE*** Long pants and heeled, closed-toed shoes are required to go horseback riding. Long pants should be sent if your kiddo would like to ride. We have most sizes of boots, but if you happen to have boots please send them.

 - T-shirt
 - Swimsuit
 - Beach Towel
 - Long pants (required)
 - Extra set of clothes
 - Tennis shoes (required)
 - Sandals (if desired)
 - Life-preserver(We have them on hand, but you are welcome to send a personal one if desired)
 - Closed-toed, heeled boots/shoes(if desired) We have boots for horseback riding, but if your camper has their own they are welcome to bring them. They have to be closed-toe and heeled though.
- **Personal Care Supplies**
 - Back-Pack/duffle bag
 - Water Bottle
 - Sunscreen
 - Insect repellent
 - Rain gear(if desired)
