DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Drop off

- You will review camper paperwork, visit the health officer for medicine/medical review and set up a camp store account.
- You will meet your camper's counselors and unload their belongings.
- Parents and campers say their goodbyes.
- Campers will start their week with fun games with their counselors and cabinmates.
- We will help campers get their belongings to their cabins and settle in once all campers have arrived at camp.

Pick up

- Families will stop to sign their campers out, pick up any medicines and receive your exit packets.
- Then they will go to the designated area to pick up their camper.
